



# ACCESS TO HOME

Helping people with disabilities to continue living comfortably and safely at home

## Overview

The **Access to Home Program** provides financial assistance to low- and moderate-income persons with disabilities for accessibility modifications, enabling them to remain in their residence rather than move into an institutional setting.

## Who is Eligible?

**Participants must meet the following criteria:**

- Documented substantial limitation caused by a disability.
- Primary, permanent residence in Schenectady or Montgomery County.
- Must be current on mortgage, property taxes, school taxes, and maintain active homeowners insurance.
- Household income at or below 80% of the Area Median Income (AMI).
- Property owner must agree to sign a Property Maintenance Declaration Form.

## In addition ...

- The assisted residential unit must be the primary, permanent residence of the eligible participant.

## Covered Modifications & Repairs

**Access to Home** provides financial assistance to make accessibility modifications such as **wheelchair ramps and lifts, handrails, doorway widening, and roll-in showers**, and similar improvements.

Funds are also available to qualified applicants for **emergency home repairs** or to address **code violations**.
