



ACCESS TO HOME FOR HEROES / VETERANS

Helping veterans with disabilities to continue living comfortably and safely at home

Overview

The **Access to Home for Heroes/ Veterans Program** provides financial assistance to low- and moderate-income veterans with disabilities for accessibility modifications so that they can remain living in their residence rather than in an institutional setting.

Who is Eligible?

Participants must meet the following criteria:

- Documented substantial limitation caused by a service-related injury, age or health related disability.
- Qualifying veteran status.
- Primary, permanent residence in Schenectady County.
- Must be current on mortgage, property taxes, school taxes, and maintain active homeowners insurance.
- Household income at or below 120% of the Area Median Income (AMI).
- Property owner must agree to sign a Property Maintenance Declaration Form.

Covered Modifications & Repairs

Access to Home provides financial assistance to make accessibility modifications such as **wheelchair ramps and lifts, handrails, doorway widening, and roll-in showers**, and similar improvements.

Funds are also available to qualified applicants for **emergency home repairs** or to address **code violations**.
