



# RESTORE PROGRAM

Helping homeowners aged 60+ address code violations and pay for emergency repairs

## Overview

The **RESTORE Program**\* provides financial assistance to senior citizens aged 60 and older for the cost of addressing emergencies and code violations that pose a threat to their health and safety or affect the livability of their home.

\* Residential Emergency Services to Offer (Home) Repairs to the Elderly

## Who is Eligible?

**Participants must meet the following criteria:**

- Must live in Schenectady or Montgomery County.
- Owns and occupies the residential unit receiving assistance as a primary residence.
- Must be sixty years of age or older.
- Must be current on mortgage, property taxes, school taxes, and have active homeowners' insurance.
- Household income at or below 100% of the Area Median Income (AMI).
- Property owner must agree to sign a Property Maintenance Declaration Form.

## Covered Repairs

**RESTORE Program** grant funds may be used to assist homeowners with completing emergency repairs, or addressing code violations. An eligible emergency repair eliminates a hazardous condition or deficiency that poses an immediate threat to the life, health and safety of the elderly homeowner.
